

Project Description: Temporary Seasonal Dock

This NOI submission is application to obtain a permit for a seasonal dock on Lake Gardner that will not require any modification to the shoreline. The proposed dock is consistent with other existing docks on Lake Gardner.

The attached plans and photographs meet the requirements detailed in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts guidebook entitled "Small Docks and Piers, A guide to Permitting Small, Pile-Supported Docks and Piers," November 2003.

The proposed seasonal dock will be located at the rear of the subject parcel at 121 Whitehall Rd on Lake Gardner. The dock is constructed of 4 foot by 8 foot aluminum frames with PVC deck panels and is 40 linear feet in length with 192 square feet of total surface area. The dock is supported by aluminum pipes with 8"x8" square aluminum pad feet resting on the lake bottom. No fill will be placed under or near the seasonal dock. The dock will not be anchored to the bank.

The dock comes in pieces that can be easily removed at the end of the season. The dock would be installed no earlier than April 15 and removed no later than October 31 of each year. Dock storage would be located more than 100 feet from the lake.
