On behalf of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) Highway District 4 Office, Greenman-Pedersen, Inc. (GPI) is submitting the enclosed request for a Certificate of Compliance for Drainage Maintenance along I-495 Northbound in Amesbury, Massachusetts. The Amesbury Conservation Commission issued an Order of Conditions (OOC) for the project on December 5th, 2025 (MassDEP File #002-1342) and the work was completed in April 2025. The OOC is recorded at the Southern Essex Registry of Deeds at Book 42607 / Page 237. The project included excavation of sediment, accumulated debris, and Common Reed (*Phragmites australis*) from an existing drainage ditch south of I-495 within the State Highway Layout (SHLO) between Mile Marker 117.1 and Mile Marker 117.3. The work was conducted in accordance with the conditions of the OOC and the plans and documentation submitted with the Notice of Intent; there were no deviations from the approved site plan. This Request for a Certificate of Compliance is being submitted in accordance with Post Construction 30 of the OOC.
