- Fourth grade students have expressed an interest in more variety in the school lunches; is the quantity consistent guidelines,
- Fifth graders are still complaining that food is running out (they have the last lunch)
- Minor/Major Behavior:
 - Minor: defined per school area (Specials, Cafeteria, Classroom, etc).
 - Major: three minor incidents, or behavior that is contrary to Code of Conduct
- Language of minor/major is from PBIS; PBIS/SEB coach, Jim Vetter will be coming out to the school on January 9, 2024
- Major behavior incidents include a student reflection and meeting with the office
- Concern about delivery of special education services; two communications were sent home; plan for compensatory services will be provided individually based on level of services missed
- Parents feel that lack of service have impacted progress on Report Cards
- Could we hire a reading specialist in place of a special education teacher
- Students have loved Spirit Week
- Replacement of Basketball Hoop in gym?
- Support for Flexible Math groups? Are the peer discussions happening at each level from low to high
- Discussion of how staff support is provided during the flexible math group time
