- Need a Quorum (majority of the members - 5)
- Assist in the identification of educational needs of the students attending the school
- Make recommendations to the principal for the development, implementation and assessment of the DCAP
- Assist in the review of the annual school budget and school implementation plan
 - Plan to improve student performance
 - EL - description of models and approaches to assist EL
- SC can grant additional authority to the School Council in terms of educational policy EXCEPT Chapter 150E: Labor Relations Public Employees
- **CONSISTS OF:**
 - Principal (Co-Chair)
 - Parents of students attending the school
 - Chosen by election run by parent org or other representative process
 - Community Members
 - Teachers
 - Students - grades 9-12 only
 - Community cannot make up more than 50% of membership
 - Principal defines composition
 - First meeting within the first 40 days from start of school
